## TUITION FEE STRUCTURE

### 2015

Fees are based on the number of children per family who attend Marian Catholic College.

Family Tuition Fee discounts are based on the number of children attending Marian Catholic College.

Discounts will be as follows;

- \* 10% discount on tuition fees ONLY for the second eldest child attending Marian Catholic College.
- \* 50% discount on tuition fees ONLY for the third eldest child attending Marian Catholic College.
- \* 100% discount on tuition fees ONLY for the fourth eldest child and thereafter attending Marian Catholic College.

The above Family Tuition Fee Discounts will be allocated to your account on the 15th December; ONLY once the account is brought into order. Discounts will not apply to accounts carried over into the following year, unless special arrangement has been made with the Business Manager.

We also offer a 2% discount on accounts paid in full by the 2<sup>nd</sup> April.

### **STUDENT FEES**

Student fees comprise of tuition, resource and book fees, co-curricular fees, sport fees, Italian (Yr8) workbooks, Art Books (Yr7 & 8), Music Books (Yr8), Look It Up resource book (Yr7 & Yr8) and averaged elective subject fees for Yrs 9-12.

Co-curricular fees – pre-planned activities experienced by the whole year group.

Sport fees – include some sport buses and entry fees during PDHPE. Also includes the annual College athletic and swimming carnivals. All other sporting excursions (e.g. BISSA, CCC) and College representative level carnivals incur an extra cost for which you will receive a specific excursion note explaining the details of the occasion and will be required to return the permission note with payment enclosed.

### **THE COLLEGE MAGAZINE**

The College Magazine (\$27.50 per family) is not included in the College Fee Statement. Each family will be notified by our College Newsletter and order slips will be distributed through your child's homeroom. The order and payment for the magazine should be submitted to the College office no later than 17<sup>th</sup> September 2015, to enable us to place our order with the printers.

### **BUILDING FUND CONTRIBUTION**

This is a tax-deductible contribution of \$100 per family, billed in Term Three only.
